On this trip an extra destination with **Siberian Jays** at a winter feeding station 2 hours drive further north is added.

Enjoy the northern winter atmosphere with crispy, cold air, snow-covered landscapes and birds like **Hawk**– and **Pygmy Owl**.

**Nutcrackers**, **Hawfinches** and **Grey-headed Woodpeckers** offer close encounters on feeding stations in different habitats. Along the road you encounter birds like **Rough-legged Buzzards**, **Great Grey Shrike** and more.

Some years **Pine Grosbeaks** are available in the area.

The itinerary is adjusted to arrival and departure times of *Ryanair* flights at closely situated *Västerås airport*. (<http://www.stockholmvasteras.se>) For those who wish to fly on other times we recommend flying to *Stockholm-Arlanda airport*, ([http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Stockholm-Arlanda\\_Airport](http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Stockholm-Arlanda_Airport)) just 1 hour drive away.

#### DAY 1

Arrival at Västerås Airport 14:00

Transfer to the Black River Valley with hot drinks and sandwiches at a **Hawfinch** garden feeder along the way. Other birds to expect on the feeding station include Bullfinch, Redpoll, Nuthatch, Yellowhammer, Greenfinch, Marsh Tit, Great tit, Blue tit, Coal tit, Great-spotted Woodpecker, Fieldfare, Blackbird, Common Jay and occasionally Arctic Redpoll, Siskin and Brambling.

Of course we spend the last minutes before dusk to look for **Pygmy Owls** perched in spruce tree-tops along the route. (It get's dark around 16:00)

#### DAY 2

Breakfast at B&B

**Hawk Owl** excursion in the Black River valley with outdoor lunch. Often the Hawk Owls perch in treetops or on telephone poles in open daylight, providing good views and photo-opportunities.

Visit at the forest feeding station for **Nutcrackers** and **Grey-headed Woodpeckers**. These birds often show really well and within close distance, providing excellent views and photo-opportunities.

Other birds at the feeders are **Crested–**, **Coal–** and **Willow Tits**, **Bullfinches**, **Nuthatches** (Scandinavian race), Great tit, Blue tit, Great-spotted Woodpecker, and occasionally **Long-tailed Tits** (of Scandinavian white-headed race).

At dusk we look for **Pygmy Owl**.

**Goshawk**, **Golden–** and **White-tailed Eagles** also frequent the area.

#### DAY 3

Breakfast at B&B

Excursion to **Siberian jay** feeding station at Ockelbo, with good chances of **Grey-headed Woodpecker** as well.

Meanwhile we enjoy the curious Jays we grill some locally produced hot dogs over an open fire.

Transfer back to the Black River Valley with short stop at the open streams of the river Dalälven for **Dippers** (Black-bellied race).

**Pygmy Owls** often appear along the road.

Night & Dinner at *Fläckebo B&B*

#### DAY 4

Breakfast at B&B

We spend the last morning looking for **White-tailed Eagles** around lake Fläcksjön.

We probe deeper into the vast taiga forest where **Black Woodpeckers** and **Black-** or **Hazel Grouse** might turn up along the way.

On request we might revisit the forest feeders for more views of **Crested Tits**, **Nutcrackers** and **Grey-headed Woodpeckers** or any locally abundant **Hawk Owl**.

**Black Grouse** and **Common Crossbills** often turn up along the forest roads.

**Waxwings** can appear in any garden in the picturesque, small villages of the valley.

Transfer to Västerås Airport with second chance to enjoy the **Hawfinches** at the feeding station along the route.
